The United States charges that:


COUNT ONE

On or about August 22, 2006, within the Eastern District of Michigan, defendant **MOHAMAD FOUAD ABDALLAH**, by threat of force, did willfully intimidate and interfere with, and attempt to intimidate and interfere with, D.S., a Jewish woman, because of D.S.'s religion and because she was and had been enjoying employment, and the perquisites thereof, by a private employer;

That is, defendant **MOHAMAD FOUAD ABDALLAH** threatened D.S. by e-mailing to her the messages, "HEY WHITE BITCH JEW.FUCK YOU.HEZBOLAAH IS AWESOME.WE WILL NEVER DIE BITCH.WERE GONNA BLOW YOU UP" (sic) and "FUCK YOU AND YOU WILL SOON BE RAPED AND WILL DIE"; all in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 245(b)(2)(C).


