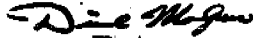

AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF  
AL AQSA EDUCATIONAL FUND, INC.

WHEREAS The Board of Trustees of Al Aqsa Educational Fund, Inc., a non-profit Mississippi Corporation, in a specially called telephonic meeting, have unanimously approved the following ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION of the corporation, the said ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION are amended as follows:

The Articles of Incorporation, Statement of Purpose, is amended to add the following language:

*The purposes for which the corporation (Al Aqsa Educational Fund, Inc.) is organized are exclusively charitable and educational within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.*

The Articles of Incorporation, Statement of Powers is amended to add the following language:

*Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization ( Al Aqsa Educational Fund, Inc.) shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income Tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.*

*Upon dissolution of the corporation (Al Aqsa Educational Fund, Inc.) assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located exclusively for such purpose or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.*
