



## **Abdullah Azzam Brigades Claims Nahariya Rocket Attack**

### **Abdullah Azzam Brigades, Battalion of Ziad Al-Jarrah, Claims Katyusha Rocket Attack on Nahariya Settlement Released: September 13, 2009**

"Praised be Allah, who supports the believers, who gave the law of Jihad in order to protect the religion and help those who are considered weak, and peace and prayer upon the last prophet and messenger, and upon his companions."

...

"The abusing Jews are still hostile toward our people in Palestine; they are (imposing) a siege, preventing prayers in the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque, building tunnels underneath it, working diligently to humiliate the Muslims and not taking into consideration their feelings and their holy assets."

"In the direction of this outrageous hostility, your brothers in the battalion of Ziad Al-Jarrah had launched two Katyusha rockets from Al-Qlaileh area in Southern Lebanon, and thanks to Allah, these two rockets hit Nahariya settlement that is located in the northern area of occupied Palestine, on Friday, in the 20th day of blessed Ramadan, 11.09.09."

"This action is included in the words of Almighty Allah: 'Fight them and Allah will punish them by your hands, cover them with shame, help you (to victory) over them, and heal the breasts of Believers and still the indignation of their hearts.'"

"They (the fighters) strive for supporting the (Islamic) religion and those who are considered weak and chase away the Jews from the land of Palestine and the rest of the apostates from the lands of the Muslims."

"We had formed a pact with Allah, Oh, Jews. You will not decide, your life will not be blessed, and you will not be rewarded with good. Our hearts still beat, blood still runs in our veins, and we are coming, with the help of Allah."

"Allah will certainly aid those who aid his (cause);- for verily Allah is full of Strength, Exalted in Might, (able to enforce His Will)"
