



## **“The Enemy is Terrified by Our Operations” November 2008**

### **“The Enemy is Terrified by Our Operations” Abdullah Mansur, *Islamic Turkestan Magazine* Released: November 2008**



*[Islamic Turkestan is published by the Turkestan Islamic Party (TIP), a splinter faction of the East Turkestan Islamic Movement (ETIM) primarily based in Waziristan and elsewhere in the North West Frontier Province of Pakistan. It is primarily comprised of Uighur Muslims from western regions of China who have sworn to wage war against the Chinese government and have carried out scattered shooting and bombing attacks. “The Chinese were terrified and shocked by the declarations of the Islamic Party of Turkestan regarding the Olympics to the degree that they reacted with contradicting responses, despite their extensive security measures and precautions. As the almighty Allah said: ‘as one whom Satan has driven to madness’ (Chapter 2, Verse 275). These measures included deploying guided missiles near the Olympic facilities hosting the opening ceremony, as well as cameras and intelligence operators throughout all roads, sports facilities, train and metro stations.”

“General Tian Yixiang, the commander of the Special Forces, who is in charge of the Rapid Intervention Forces protecting the Olympics from internal and external threats, said that they had deployed 34 thousand troops around the Olympic facilities, 74 reconnaissance aircraft for discovering bombs and hidden explosives, 48 helicopters and 33 boats, as well as devices for dealing with chemical and biological weapons. The Chinese government had been expecting Turkestan Muslims to carry out terrorist attacks during the Olympic Games, but several days after these attacks actually occurred they announced that these were ‘natural incidents’ that had not been perpetrated by the Muslims. This is the contradiction in their declarations. In conclusion, the Chinese feared the announcements made by the Islamic Party of Turkestan and were terrified by its first wave of attacks.”

“As Allah's Apostle said: ‘I have been given five things which were not given to any amongst the prophets before me. The first thing is that Allah made me victorious by awe (by His frightening my enemies) for a distance of one month's journey.’ The period during which the Olympic Games were held was an extremely sensitive time for the Chinese government. The Islamic Party of Turkistan had been aware of this and they had spent three years preparing for this period. The party was firm in its decision not to miss this chance and carry out military operations. Due to the prayers and the efforts of the righteous brothers, the Islamic Party of Turkistan had shot the first bullet in China's head. Allah had answered their prayers and they were not left disappointed. The almighty Allah had granted success and the Mujahidin managed to carry out several operations before and during the Olympic Games, despite the Chinese state of alert, and the praise to Allah. We pray Allah to accept our righteous martyrs in Paradise and to grant patience and firm stand to our prisoners in the prisons of the oppressors.”

“It has been 50 years since these sorts of operations took place inside China. China has removed its guise of moderation and honor to assault the people of Turkistan, none of whom is safe from this vicious onslaught. The Chinese are trembling in fear at the sight of a Turkestani and they rush to inform the police whenever they learn that a Turkestani is present. This situation resulted in the Chinese government expelling all the Turkestanis from China proper, with some being imprisoned and interrogated. The Chinese have banned Turkestanis from entering hotels

and traveling by airlines. They have even dismissed several flight captains from their jobs. As far as the Chinese government is concerned, all Uighars have become terrorists.”

“Several Mujahidin brothers from Turkestan who had been waiting for the call to Jihad, had been influenced by the announcements of the Islamic Party and had carried out several operations inside Turkestan:”

- (1) “04/08/08 – Four days before the opening of the Olympics two Mujahidin warriors drove their car, loaded with explosives, into a group of Chinese Border Guard troops during their morning physical training exercise in Kashgar. One of the brothers disembarked the car and attacked them with an explosive device. The other ran over the other troops and then detonated the car, in what was a heroic and unique operation. The Chinese government announced on its radio broadcasts that 16 troops were killed and 17 injured. All of them were troops from the Border Guard. President Bush has sent a letter of condolences to the Chinese government, describing the incident as ‘criminal’ and ‘terrorist!’”
- (2) “07/08/08 – One day before the opening of the Olympics, several Mujahidin brothers attacked security patrols with machine guns in the town of (incomprehensible word). They had killed 8 troops and withdrew in peace, praise to Allah.”
- (3) “08/08/08 – On the day of the opening of the Olympics, a Mujahid detonated a bomb on a police convoy in the Ili prefecture, killing 9 policemen. This incident was also mentioned on Al-Jazeera TV.”
- (4) “10/08/08 – Clashes between Mujahidin and police in the Kucha market. The brothers attacked the police headquarters, the courthouse, a building owned by the customs and a building owned by the Center for Birth Restriction. The brothers also shattered several supermarket shops owned by Chinese.”
- (5) “12/08/08 – Clashes between policemen and Mujahidin who were driving through checkpoints in the town of Peyziwat in the Kashgar prefecture. The Mujahidin had slaughtered three policemen with their knives and escaped. The police went to search for them in the village of Buya, where they were informed of the identity of a woman who was escorting the Mujahidin. They went to arrest her and found her in her farm, where the Mujahidin had placed an ambush for them. When the police came to arrest her, the Mujahidin attacked them, killing their commander and another policeman and injuring four more. The other policemen managed to escape.”

“In the light of these blessed operations, we can say that the Muslims of Eastern Turkestan are longing for a call to Jihad. The Chinese Communists have been oppressing them, but they have awoken from their deep sleep. There is nothing they like more than the noise of gunfire and the sound of guns and explosives. They have made up their minds and they are not hiding themselves behind their weapons. After these operations the Chinese government had placed checkpoints on every road and pass, inspecting travelers and harassing them. They have also started recording new statistics regarding the population of Turkestan. Under this false cover they wish to understand the weak points of the Muslims and reveal their secrets: Who are the believers? Who are the devout believers? They have arrested and imprisoned many devout young men. They have launched campaigns of car inspections and finally decided that all passengers in all forms of transportation must carry their identity cards with them. If a driver transports passengers who do not carry identity cards, his car is confiscated. O, proud people of Turkistan! If you wish to be free from the Chinese oppression, you have no choice but to face the various hardships posed by this path. You must not abandon your Mujahidin sons. You ought not to listen to the hypocrites who attack the Mujahidin, doubt their intentions and frustrate all the people around them. Do not listen to what the Chinese enemy publishes in its newspapers and reports on its radio news broadcasts. It only wishes to attack the Mujahidin, describing them as ‘terrorists’, ‘extremists’ and ‘saboteurs’. Do not trust them and beware their deceptions. The path of Jihad is filled with trials and hardships. The almighty Allah said: ‘Fighting is prescribed for you, and ye dislike it. But it is possible that ye dislike a thing which is good for you, and that ye love a thing which is bad for you. But Allah knoweth, and ye know not’ (Chapter 2, Verse 216).”

“To the Mujahidin who are fighting in Turkestan, who have taken the path of glory to defend their belief, honor and homeland: Be patient and remain firm on your path. Proceed in this path restlessly until we drive the Chinese away from our lands. The almighty Allah said: ‘And slacken

not in following up the enemy: If ye are suffering hardships, they are suffering similar hardships; but ye have Hope from Allah, while they have none. And Allah is full of knowledge and wisdom' (Chapter 4, verse 104)."
